Cultural

Event Name: Harbin International Ice and Snow Festival

Date: December 2023 - February, 2024

Description: Welcome to the largest ice and snow festival in the world! A captivating winter celebration that takes place annually in Harbin, located in northeast China. Renowned for its colossal ice sculptures, intricate snow carvings, and vibrant light displays, the festival transforms the city into a magical wonderland. Visitors worldwide flock to witness the breathtaking frozen masterpieces and experience the enchanting atmosphere.





Event Name: Tibetan New Year Date: February 10-12, 2024

Description: Also known as Losar, this period marks the beginning of the Tibetan lunar calendar and is the most important festival of the year for Tibetan Buddhists. Celebrated in Tibet and Tibetan regions like Shangri-La (Yunnan province) and Jiuzhaigou (Sichuan province), vibrant festivities involve religious rituals, traditional dances, and family gatherings. Symbolising the triumph of good over evil, Losar holds cultural significance, blending spiritual practices with joyous expressions of community unity and renewal. Lasting for up to 15 days, most of the best parts of Losar occur within the first three days.





Event Name: Water-Splashing Festival of Dai People

Date: April 13-15, 2024

Description: A vibrant and exuberant celebration that takes place annually in Xishuangbanna in southwest Yunnan province. Rooted in local traditions, it marks the Dai New Year and is renowned for its water-related festivities. The festival symbolises cleansing and renewal, with locals and visitors engaging in spirited water fights as well as traditional dances, processions, and religious ceremonies. Similar to neighboring Thailand's Songkran Festival, it involves three days of celebrations.





Event Name: Miao Sisters Festival

Date: April 23-25, 2024

Description: Celebrated by the Miao people in Guizhou province, this vibrant occasion honours sisterhood and is a celebration of love and spring. Held annually, it features traditional dances, songs, and intricate embroidery showcasing Miao culture. The festival fosters unity among women, celebrating their bond and preserving the rich unique heritage of the Miao community.





Event Name: March Street Festival of Bai People

Date: April 23-29, 2024

Description: A grand event celebrated by the local Bai people in Dali in southwest Yunnan province. Also known as the Guanyin Fair, this bustling street fest is held at the foot of Cangshan Mountain above Dali Old Town and has developed into one of the largest commodity markets in the province. During the festival, businessmen from in and around Dali gather to participate in selling a variety of goods combined with food stalls and cultural performances, creating a lively atmosphere that attracts locals and visitors alike.





Event Name: Dragon Boat Festival

Date: June 10, 2024

Description: Also known as Duanwu or Zhongxiao Festival, this traditional Chinese holiday is celebrated on the 5th day of the 5th month of the lunar calendar. Originating from ancient rituals, it honours Qu Yuan, a patriotic poet. The festival features dragon boat races, zongzi (rice dumplings), and vibrant cultural festivities.





Event Name: Naadam Festival Date: July 11-15, 2024

Description: Naadam refers to entertainments or games in Mongolian. The festival is a vibrant celebration of the region's nomadic culture, featuring the "Three Manly Games" of wrestling, horse racing, and archery. This annual event in Inner Mongolia showcases traditional Mongolian customs, with participants adorned in colourful attire and displaying exceptional skill in these age-old competitions.





Event Name: Torch Festival of Yi People

Date: July 29-31, 2024

Description: In southwest Yunnan province, ethnic groups of the region including the Yi, Bai, Hani, Lahu, Naxi, and Pumi people come together for a vibrant celebration marked by torchlit processions, traditional dances, and folk music. Held annually, it symbolises unity, warding off evil spirits, and praying for a good harvest. The festival reflects the rich cultural heritage and community spirit of the Yi people.





Event Name: Tibet Shoton Festival

Date: August 4-10, 2024

Description: A vibrant celebration, also known as the "Yogurt Banquet Festival". Highlighted by the unveiling of giant thangkas (religious paintings), monks' chanting, and the sharing of yogurt, it marks the end of monks' seclusion during the summer. The festival showcases Tibetan culture, spirituality, and communal joy.





Event Name: Mid-Autumn Festival

Date: September 17, 2024

Description: Also known as the Moon Festival or Mooncake Festival, the Chinese cultural festival signifies family reunions and harvest abundance. On the 15th day of the lunar calendar, families gather, enjoy mooncakes, and appreciate the full moon's beauty. Lanterns illuminate the night, symbolising unity and good fortune. It's a cherished tradition, blending cultural, familial, and celestial elements.






Event Name: China Electronics Exhibition (CEF)






Event Name: The Canton Fair






Event Name: China International Import Expo (CIIE)
